Students have until April 5 to apply

AVONDALE, ARIZONA, March 28 – Estrella Mountain Community College (EMCC) students who have met or will meet their certificate or degree requirements in fall 2018, spring 2019, or summer 2019 have until April 5 to apply for graduation. Students must apply for graduation to have their degree(s) or certificate(s) officially awarded on their college transcripts.

The 23rd Annual Commencement Ceremony is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. May 10, 2019, at Grand Canyon University, 3300 W. Camelback Road, Phoenix.
